

# CUHAS-BUGANDO JOINING INSTRUCTIONS 2011/2012

---

1. We are pleased to inform you that you have been selected for admission to the Catholic University of Health and Allied Sciences-Bugando (CUHAS-Bugando) formerly Weill Bugando University College of Health Sciences into the **BPHARM programme** for the **2011/2012 Academic Year**.

1.1 You should report to the University, which is located within the Bugando Medical Centre building complex, at Bugando in Mwanza, between 9 am – 4 pm on **1<sup>st</sup> October (Saturday), or 2<sup>nd</sup> (Sunday), 2011** for **Orientation Activities** which begin on **3<sup>rd</sup> October 2011 (Monday)**.

1.2 You will need to bring with you your ORIGINAL form four (4) and form six (6) Certificates, or NECTA – CERTIFIED Copies thereof, with your means of identification, as well as Medical Certificate of fitness and two passport sized photos; if you have not submitted them already.

## 2.0 Payment of Fees and Registration

2.1 Fees and other financial obligations are the sole responsibility of the student and/or the sponsor or guardian. Fees are payable in full at the beginning of each academic year or in two equal installments; at the beginning of each semester. Fees payable are detailed below:

- (i) All candidates are required to pay the following administrative fees in full at the beginning of the academic year:

- (ii) Self sponsored students are required to pay the following academic fees payable to the University in full at the beginning of the academic year or in two equal instalments; at the beginning of each semester.

(iii) All students with proof of full sponsorship of HESLB or government are required to pay **1,100,000/=** which is the difference of the Tuition fees as their contribution to the fees, in full at the beginning of the academic year or in two equal instalments at the beginning of each semester.

(iv) **Other Costs**

All sponsors, parents, guardians should be aware that other costs payable to the student in the course of training include meals, stationery, books, field work/elective.

### 3.0 Hostel Accommodation

The University has limited accommodation facilities on campus for which the students are requested to **pay 480,000/= per year. This should be paid in full or 2 installments.** Students are advised to make use of this facility. Preference will be given to female, foreign, disable and clinical students and those that are prepared to pay the fee in full at the beginning of the academic year.

#### 4.0 All moneys payable to the University should be paid directly into the University account presently with CRDB.

4.2 CUHAS-Bugando will not handle student's personal money. Any extra money included in the fees will be assumed to be prepayments for the subsequent year. Please note that no student will be allowed to carry forward part of the fee into the following academic year.

5.0 Every selected candidate is requested to report to the University with adequate funds to meet costs not covered by government grant or the Higher Education Student Loan Board, personal expenses and other urgent needs that might arise
