



# CUHAS-BUGANDOMPH JOINING INSTRUCTIONS 2018/2019

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1. We are pleased to inform you that you have been selected for admission to the Catholic University of Health and Allied Sciences-Bugando(CUHAS-Bugando) formerly Weill Bugando University College of Health Sciences into the **MPH programme** for the **2018/2019 Academic Year**; in the specialty as indicated.
  - 1.1 You should report to the University, which is located within the Bugando Medical Centre building complex, at Bugando in Mwanza, between 9am – 4pm on **22<sup>nd</sup> October (Monday), 2018 in time for the beginning of the academic year** which starts immediately on 29<sup>th</sup> October (Monday) 2018.
  - 1.2 You will need to bring with you your ORIGINALMD Certificates, or its equivalent, with your means of identification, as well as Medical Certificate of fitness and two passport sized photos; if you have not submitted them already.

## 2.0 Payment of Fees and Registration

- 2.1 Fees and other financial obligations are the sole responsibility of the student and/or the sponsor or guardian. Fees are payable in full at the beginning of each academic year or in two equal installments; at the beginning of each semester. Fees payable are detailed below:

- (i) All candidates are required to pay the following administrative fees in full at the beginning of the academic year:

- (ii) Self-sponsored students are required to pay the following academic fees payable to the University in full at the beginning of the academic year or in two equal instalments; at the beginning of each semester.

(iii) All sponsored students should report with proof of sponsorship. The fees should be in full at the beginning of the academic year or in two equal instalments at the beginning of each semester.

**(iv) Other Costs**

All sponsors, parents, guardians should be aware that other costs payable to the student in the course of training include a stipend of **3,600,000/=** stationery/books allowance of **850,000/=** Research/Dissertation **3,000,000/=**.

**3.0 Hostel Accommodation**

The University has limited accommodation facilities on campus for which the students are requested to **pay 1,200,000/= per year. This should be paid in full. This cost does not include utilities**

**4.0 All money payable to the University should be paid directly into the University account presently with CRDB.**

5.0 Every selected candidate is requested to report to the University with adequate funds to meet costs not covered by government grant or the Higher Education Student Loan Board, personal expenses and other urgent needs that might arise.

6.0 **All students are required to open bank accounts with CRDB Bank to facilitate easy disbursement of funds for Meals from MoHSW. For any student who will prefer to use different bank will incur all transactions expenses.**
